Statement of Advice:

ceftazidime/avibactam 2g/0.5g powder for concentrate for solution for infusion (Zavicefta®) SMC No 1307/18

Pfizer Ltd

8 December 2017

ADVICE: in the absence of a submission from the holder of the marketing authorisation

ceftazidime/avibactam (Zavicefta®) is not recommended for use within NHS Scotland.

Indication under review: Treatment of the following infections in adults:

- complicated intra-abdominal Infection (cIAI)
- complicated urinary tract infection (cUTI), including pyelonephritis
- hospital-acquired pneumonia (HAP), including ventilator-associated pneumonia (VAP)
- infections due to aerobic Gram-negative organisms in adult patients with limited treatment options

The holder of the marketing authorisation has not made a submission to SMC regarding this product in this indication. As a result we cannot recommend its use within NHSScotland.
